You are cordially invited to participate in the 2015 WWA NJFL Tournament and Student Congress to be held on October 21, 2016 from 4:30pm-9pm. The tournament will be held at Woodrow Wilson Academy in Westminster, CO.

Events: We will host three (3) rounds of competition in Drama, Humor, Duo Interp, Poetry, Prose, and Public Forum Debate. There is <u>no</u> double-entering allowed.

Debate Resolutions: We will use the fall PF topic of "Resolved: Civil disobedience in a democracy is morally justified."

Entries: Each school may enter a maximum of 4 entries in each event. Entries will be handled on a first-come, first served basis. Registration will occur online at www.speechmeets.com. Registration will close on October 17, but may close sooner based on entries received.

Judges: Each school is expected to provide 1 judge for each 4 events entries and 1 judge for each 2 debate entries.

Registration and Schedule: Registration will be held from 4:00-4:30pm. Rounds will begin at 4:30pm. Awards are scheduled for 9pm.

Rules: Competition is open to 6-8 grade students representing the school in which they are officially enrolled and doing so with the permission of their school administration and/or coaches.

Awards: We will award numerous superior and excellent ribbons and hope to present some seasonal prizes. Awards are scheduled for 9pm.

Concessions: A concessions stand will be available for students. Food will be furnished for coaches and judges.
